GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 6:41-51

This reading from John's gospel begins with a note of skepticism from Jesus' audience who are saving. 'Who does He think He is?' We often overlook the fact that Jesus was a poet; He spoke in parables that He had made up and His speech was continually peppered with metaphors and poetic allusions. Here He is declaring that He is the Agent of nourishment for our spiritual relationship with God. However, when He says He is heaven-sent then His listeners get their backs up because they know His origin; they know of His father, Joseph, and His mother. What's this talk about coming from heaven? In misunderstanding the poetry of Jesus' language, they imagine Him claiming to have stepped out of the sky and settled in Judea. How simplistic! They forget that their revered prophets were heaven-sent, they forget that their kings of former times were all 'sons of God' and represented God for their people, as stated in Psalm 2.

Everything about Jesus is food and drink for our spiritual life.

There are so many ways we can become one with Christ in our interaction with others and in our effort to nourish our interior life. Let's not forget that this journey to growth requires healthy self-acceptance, determination and effort.


