

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

Luke is making the point that John had made such a significant impact that some people wondered if he might be the Messiah. John himself puts paid to this idea and he refers to his washing ritual as a prelude to the much more important reality of being immersed or engulfed in the Holy Spirit. But how do we live a life that is immersed in the Spirit or, as the poetry of the Hebrew Scriptures puts it, walking in the Spirit? Jesus suggests it is being guided by His spirituality, which is a relational way of having our thoughts and intentions directed by that love of the other that makes compassion and integrity the fire in our belly that governs everything we do.

In the second half of today's reading we are offered a picture of Jesus stepping up to be washed or dipped in the Jordan by John. The three Synoptic Gospels make it clear that Jesus does not need to change His way of life or turn back to God. So, He is not signing on to John's message of *metanoia* or repentance. Rather, this becomes an epiphany where the Divine Voice speaks out a message of love and approval of Jesus as Son. We could say that He was immersed in the Spirit and we have here the presence of Father, Son and Spirit in one scene.


