GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 6:51-58

This is a further extract from the 'Bread of Life' discourse in John 6. It is good to recall that at the end of this section John tells us that Jesus was speaking in the synagogue at Capernaum. The synagogue reading that no doubt gave rise to Jesus' words was Exodus 16 where God tells Moses He is going to rain down bread from heaven to feed the Israelites wandering in the desert. The homily or reflection after the reading is provided by Jesus referring to Himself as the Spiritual Bread from heaven.

We can easily identify with the bewilderment leading to outrage in the people listening to Jesus. The drinking of blood was strictly forbidden by the law of Leviticus (17:10-14) so the words of Jesus would have stirred anger. But, of course, interpreting Jesus literally is out of the question. As we read in the first reading today Lady Wisdom provides Bread and Wine as the nourishment for a quality life. And in Jewish tradition Torah provides the necessary food and drink for spiritual sustenance and growth.

We understand that these rich metaphors are referring to food and drink for the spiritual life. So here Jesus is providing Himself as the Food of authentic life.

John makes it clear with the words of Jesus that true discipleship lies in being one with Jesus.


