**GOSPEL REFLECTION:** Luke 10:38-42

This is the well-known Martha and Mary story that tells of Martha offering hospitality to Jesus and His followers during their stopover stay in Bethany on their way to Jerusalem. A conversation develops and Jesus is speaking while Mary, the younger sister, hangs on His every word. Her expression of hospitality is to give rapt attention to what He has to say and it was customary for students to sit at the feet of their Master as He taught. What is unusual here is that a woman is in the position of student. Mary's posture indicates her openness and zeal to learn. In contrast, Martha is busy preparing food for the guests and is thereby doing what is expected of women of the house.

We know the story well enough and can sympathise with Martha who becomes frustrated in her food preparation and asks Jesus to get Mary to give her a hand. Jesus sees a teachable moment here to comment on His scale of values. He tells Martha that she is anxious and troubled about many things when, really, only one thing is necessary. The implication here is that in this moment Martha has her priorities askew. Mary is on the right track realising that spiritual issues are more important than domestic duties.

The best we can do is take away the message that our energetic concern for the practical needs of life should not cause us to overlook or even demote our care for spiritual growth. Mary has made the choice that listening intently to her guest was a nobler form of hospitality. This was her way of being truly present to Jesus.
