

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 23:35-43

Putting these readings together and knowing the nature and spirituality of Jesus we can see a contradiction in the concept of Christ as King. We commonly associate kings with attributes like dominance, wealth and force and yet nothing could be further from the person of Jesus. Conjure up the image of Jesus stripping to His undies and washing the feet of His friends. This is about service, the kind of genuine service that can add colour and sunshine to the life of another. It creates and enhances relationship and is galaxies away from dominance.

Jesus spoke about treasure in heaven and the aimlessness of striving after wealth at the cost of losing oneself. No king in our world can afford to be without wealth and the things that money can buy and we have Jesus urging the rich man to give up his hankering for possessions and follow the poor man of Nazareth in pursuit of spiritual treasure.

As for force, Jesus is the very antithesis of force. His whole mission is offering an invitation to follow - take it or leave it; no obligation. There is nothing in the person or teaching of Jesus that smacks of control. On the contrary, He guarantees that those who follow His way will enjoy deep peace in their inmost being. 
