GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 6:60-69

This is the last section of the Bread of Life discourse in John and it contains the response of the disciples through the affirmation of Peter. It is unfortunate that the lectionary editors have chosen to omit verse 40 from the three sections of John 6 that were selected for these Sundays. The omitted verse is a key statement from Jesus that gives us a deeper insight into the nature of belief in John's gospel.

This is indeed the will of My Father, that all who see the Son and believe in Him may have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day. John 6:40

Belief in Jesus is a critical factor in this gospel. However, the force of the Greek verb *pisteuo* goes way beyond 'I believe' as believing a statement or the truth. It far surpasses creeds and doctrines because it is not an act of the mind; it is a commitment of the whole self. In the context of today's gospel it means to commit oneself to somebody in complete confidence. By committing myself completely to Christ with trust I become one with the Bread of Life, the source of all I need for my spiritual growth.

To conclude his work John writes that our faith commitment is the key to intimacy with Christ and ultimate life.

But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in His name. John 20:31.

At His last meal with His friends Jesus will define love for one another as the way we express our intimacy with Him.


