

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 2:41-52**

There is strong human interest in this story which should make it easy to proclaim and engaging to hear. Any parent will easily identify with the panic and anxiety of Mary and Joseph as they go searching for Jesus. Those with experience of teenage children will recognise their need to assert a certain independence. But there is more to the story than this.

Jesus is in the Temple, listening to the learned and asking them intelligent questions. They were impressed. But there is also a sense that this is where Jesus belongs – in God's house, occupied with the affairs of God the Father. There is a destiny unfolding here that they do not yet understand. As Simeon had foreshadowed, Jesus would be destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel.

Nevertheless, the reading finishes with human warmth and depicts a loving and orderly family. There is no conflict between allegiance to God and to our human parents. As Jesus grows in stature, so also He increases in wisdom and finds favour with God and others. Almost two decades pass before we hear more about Jesus – when He begins His public ministry with baptism by John.
