GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 14:1, 7-14

Luke tells the story of the time Jesus was invited to dine with one of the leading Pharisees. In first century Jewish society an invitation to a meal was usually a sign of honour, friendship and even intimacy, but in this case Luke is implying that the Pharisees were keeping a close watch on Jesus, no doubt seeking to find fault with him. So, Jesus took advantage of the situation to make a valuable point by means of a story. True enough Jesus is offering practical advice about how to behave as a worthy guest, not presuming to take the best place at table, but rather waiting to be seated by the host. Taking the best place stems from an over inflated self-image.

In this little scenario Jesus is saying that to avoid shame a guest should not presume to be more honourable than anyone else, but should recognise, not only with humility but also with common sense, that others may be more important.

Honest folks will have a true opinion of themselves and will not consider themselves better than others. Traditional spirituality calls this humility, and it is this down-to-earth honesty that allows us to see ourselves in a true light, where there is no room for showing-off or self-deception.

Jesus' final remarks in this reading again urge us to be honest and sincere in our relationships with others.


