

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM ARCHBISHOP SHANE: I am pleased to announce that, effective 1 January 2026, Liturgy Brisbane has transitioned organisationally under the umbrella of Archdiocesan Ministries. This move presents valuable opportunities for both Liturgy Brisbane and Archdiocesan Ministries. These two areas have enjoyed a long-standing constructive working relationship, and this transition will allow us to further strengthen that collaboration. Importantly, there will be no practical changes to the publications, mission or service provisions of Liturgy Brisbane, Ultimately, this enhanced partnership will better serve the parishes and communities across our Archdiocese and the wider Church in Australia.	

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Matthew 5:1-12	
Matthew has put in one place a selection of Jesus' beatitudes as a masthead to the teachings that follow. It helps to realise that Matthew has written his gospel for a largely Jewish community. Having asked for baptism and adhering to the teaching of Jesus these people are wondering if they have turned away from the teachings of Moses and the prophets that make up their long Jewish religious tradition. In chapters 5-7 Matthew will demonstrate that Jesus has not gone against Moses but is, in fact, fulfilling the tradition of Moses.	
A significant aspect of beatitudes in general is that they occur everywhere in the Hebrew Scriptures. The Hebrew beatitude always begins with <i>ashrei</i> , which means noble or blessed.	
Jesus is talking about a state of being blessed, approved of, or favoured, which is different from feeling joyful or delighted.	
In the first of these beatitudes the expression 'poor in spirit' is very often misinterpreted as being humble. The problem with this is that 'poor in spirit' in the Hebrew Bible more often means 'crushed in spirit'. So, Jesus is saying it is a blessed thing to be crushed in spirit because it gives a person grounds to turn to God for relief. To a society where suffering was regarded as a punishment from God Jesus is saying that such an equation is rarely justified. On the contrary, God is on the side of decent people who are suffering from stress. If I can feel your pain in my heart and respond with kindness and compassion then, Jesus is saying, it is a blessed thing. – Laurie Woods


