GOSPEL REFLECTION: Matthew 2:1-12

The Magi are associated with magic and represent the wisdom of the East. Matthew is using the ancient eastern practice of astrology to draw attention to the wisdom of these visitors. They have observed an unusual astronomical phenomenon and their immediate reaction is to realise that a divine power is responsible. This is why they follow the star. The gospel never tells us how many wise men there are but because there is an offering of three gifts it has been traditional to count three wise men. Matthew has taken up a theme of the Hebrew Scriptures that mention gifts of gold coming from Sheba and the nations (Ps 72:10f.)

The Magi offer gifts of gold, which represents royalty, frankincense, which is a fragrant resin that was used to create the sweet aroma of incense. Frankincense was used solely for worship and its presence here indicates that the Magi have come to worship the baby Jesus. This is Matthew's way of showing the faith of the gentile wise men who see in the newly born baby God's representative. The third gift of myrrh represents the Magi's recognition of Jesus as the Messiah. Myrrh was a fragrant ingredient in the compound oil that was used for sacred anointing and for the embalming of corpses. The Messiah was a specially anointed One, set apart for the unique task of bringing about the fulfilment of the Kingdom of God. The myrrh here represents the anointing of Jesus as Messiah and also foreshadows His death.
