### **GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 17:5-9**

Today's gospel reading begins with a prime example of the poetry of Jesus. He uses a simile to show how even the tiniest amount of genuine faith will produce virtual miracles. Just prior to this request from the disciples Jesus had been saying that in the light of human weakness people were bound to stumble, do the wrong thing at times, and even go off the rails, but a greater sin is committed by those who lead people astray, who deceive and convince others of their negative values.

The faith Jesus is talking about is rendered by the Aramaic word haimanutha, which does not refer mainly to doctrines and creeds but has a root meaning related to firmness, faithfulness, confidence. It really describes the committed disciple's state of being, which is marked by a firm confidence and trust in the Divine.

The short parable that Jesus offers of the appropriate relationship between master and servant/slave runs the risk of jarring our modern sensitivities. The parable assumes a household with a single servant who attends to multiple needs. Faithful service to the master is the key to his job description. Jesus is making the point here that just as the servant fulfils his purpose in life by serving the master, so, the disciples' purpose in life is to carry out the expectations of the God they serve. Living according to the values of Christ is the natural corollary of our firm commitment to Him.

In this parable Jesus uses the image of slavery to reflect the total commitment, loyalty and devotion we owe to God and we are aware that this attitude will help bring us closer to the reality that God is.


