GOSPEL REFLECTION: Mark 10:2-16

The gospel extract represents a response from Jesus to the Pharisees' question about divorce. In Jesus' day divorce of married couples was an accepted practice, though not without certain restrictions. There was a noted imbalance in the Jewish Torah that gave the husband exclusive right to end a marriage for a wife's breach of loyalty. He had to write a formal bill of divorce and pay a form of alimony to the wife. Over time, however, the rabbis introduced additional limitations on the husband that improved the circumstances of wives.

In His answer to the Pharisees Jesus admits that the law provided for divorce only because of the hardness of the hearts of the people, but in the beginning, divorce was not on the agenda. Rather, God had designed it so that couples would stay together for the good of the family. Here again is a statement of the ideal with no consideration of individual cases. Jesus does not go into any of the practical 'what ifs?' nor does He take into account the various situations that might lead to dissolving a marriage as the better option for the good of all concerned. So, there is no discussion of any of the issues that crop up in modern life.

This same episode occurs in Matthew's gospel but there Jesus presents an exception, namely, if the wife is involved in sexual misconduct (the Greek word used is porneia) then the husband has the right to divorce her. It is curious to note, though, that Paul does not interpret Jesus absolutely. In writing to the Corinthians he forsees a certain difficulty if a Christian is married to a non-Christian and the relationship falls apart due to clashes of beliefs and values. In such a case, he allows, if the non-Christian party separates then the Christian is not bound but is free to marry again. (1Cor 7:15). Paul certainly accepts the ideal as set out by Jesus, but aware of the complexities of human relationships he adds a common-sense bottom line criterion that 'it is to peace that God has called you' (1Cor 7:15).


