

Each year from 1 September to 4 October, the Christian family unites for the Season of Creation, a worldwide celebration of prayer and action to protect our common home.

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 14:25-33**

The gospel reading today is about priorities. It starts off with a pretty confronting statement about hating family – parents, siblings, spouse, relatives, children.

At no point would Jesus encourage hatred of family, but here He is making an unambiguous statement in a Semitic style of speech. He is saying that we cannot be half-hearted about following Him. It's impossible to be a casual or part-time Christian. Following Christ means a life commitment and that's a top priority. You either love Christ or you don't. This is Jesus' uncompromising way of emphasising the importance of discipleship.

The two parables that Jesus then delivers are examples of His down-to-earth grip on reality. All undertakings should be preceded by planning and careful calculation. Only a fool rushes into an enterprise without due consideration. In the same way, Christians should do what they can to muster the perseverance and courage to follow Christ with commitment, even if it means undergoing suffering and loss.

The implication is, if you prefer fame, fortune, reputation and your possessions to following Christ, then go for it. But don't expect to finish up achieving your potential as human being by having an each-way bet. A life without a vibrant spirituality is bound to be unfulfilling, lacking in wholeness and maturity and ending in regrets and tears. We can't hang on to our security blankets and 'things' and still be committed followers of Jesus Christ.


