GOSPEL REFLECTION: Matthew 5:13-16

Today's gospel passage continues Jesus' words in Galilee but these are addressed to His disciples and not to the crowds in general. He is telling His followers that they are the salt of the earth. This is high praise indeed, and extremely encouraging.

In the ancient Jewish world salt was linked to covenant faithfulness, mainly because it doesn't lose its flavour but retain its qualities in spite of being mixed with other substances. This is the kind of fidelity and perseverance that Jesus calls for. God forbid that salt should lose its flavour! But should this unlikely event ever happen then the salt is totally useless. What an indictment it would be if I ceased to be faithful! I would risk being useless. A fate worse than death, as the saying goes.

Calling His disciples the light of the world Jesus is saying that their goodness and compassion should shine, not in the sense of seeking attention or grandstanding, but simply as a result of being genuinely wholesome and sincere.

The telling point that Jesus added was that people would see the good works of the disciples. The bottom line is, speaking out the good news of Jesus needs to be reinforced with appropriate behaviour. After all, actions speak louder than words and the integrity and compassion of the disciples would provide a convincing and powerful back-up to their preaching.

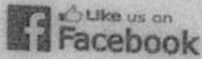
