





# SYNOD 24: I AM MAKING ALL THINGS NEW – 1. SYNOD 24: I Am Making All Things New will be held in September and October.

- 2. If you and/or other members of your parish will be attending the synod. (A full list of Synod Members will be published closer to the time).
- 3. Our Archdiocesan synod is the next step on the Plenary Council journey and will discern practical and measurable actions that we will take as an Archdiocese to implement the focus areas (Decrees) that came out of the Plenary Council.
- 4. We are all asked to pray for those participating in the synod.
- 5. Resources for parishes and communities to engage in synodal conversations and spiritual conversations will be made available at the end of June. These resources will include simple versions of the Plenary Council Decrees and guided questions so the community can discern actions they would like to take to be a more co-responsible church on mission.
- 6. There will be a series of presentations given around the Archdiocese in July and August on what synodality actually is, what it means for the global church and for our own community. Information on these presentations will be made available in the next two weeks.

#### PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION:

In the Archdiocese of Brisbane, we take this collection up as a retiring collection. This year's collection will be taken up on the 29/30 June 2024, at the Masses the weekend around the Feast of Sts Peter and Paul.

#### GOSPEL REFLECTION: Mark 4:35-41

Having read extracts from Psalm 107 of today's readings we can appreciate it as background to Mark's narrative of the calming of the storm on the lake. The psalmist describes sailors being in fear of their lives as huge waves of the sea threaten to swamp ships. And then God delivers them by calming the storm.

Mark is using the scene of Jonah sleeping in the hold of the ship that was being thrown about by a fierce storm in the Mediterranean. The sailors jettison cargo to lighten the load but Jonah doesn't stir. Who can be fast asleep during a storm that is tossing the ship about like a cork? The ship's captain goes to Jonah and wakes him up urging him to call on his God. Jonah, of course, is powerless and, what's more, he has boarded this ship precisely to get away from the divine command to go to the city of Nineveh and preach repentance. At that point, his shares with God are pretty low. Jesus has actually gone one better than Jonah, he has a cushion to rest on.

Notice the question the disciples put to Jesus after they wake him up, 'Don't you care?' The implication is, "You can do something about this storm.' There is faith mixed with fear here, but fear seems to have the upper hand. After Jesus calmed the storm the disciples were awestruck and they wondered who this could be who was able to still the wind and the sea.
